**The mission of the Northfield Township Food Pantry is to provide assistance to Township residents who are having trouble providing food for themselves and their families.**

Dear Friends,

Thanks to the generous donations of food, financial assistance and volunteer hours, the Northfield Township Food Pantry was able to help a record number of low-income families during the past year. Our client base continues to increase as economic hardship touches more and more local families. However, with your help, we're still able to give assistance to almost 1,300 residents every month.

During the March 2009-February 2010 fiscal year, the Pantry:

- Provided monthly and weekly assistance to an average of 423 local families (an average of 1,292 individuals).
- Extended the produce distribution program; clients can now pick up fresh fruits and vegetables weekly.
- Distributed over \$101,000 in monthly grocery gift cards.
- Continued to distribute extra food and grocery cards during our November, December and Springtime holiday programs.
- Gave out over 300 sets of school supplies to our client's elementary and high school students.
- Distributed Easter/Spring baskets and birthday gifts to clients' children.

- Hosted a Halloween “Trunk and Treat” event for clients’ children.
